

Studies in American Language TOEFL Waiver Program

ATTEND UNDERGRADUATE PROGRAMS OR GRADUATE PROGRAMS

WITHOUT THE REQUIRED TOEFL SCORE

Just follow these 5 easy steps:

Step 1:

Complete a minimum of one session of all Expansion 2 level classes at SAL (including E2 WC) for transfer to Undergraduate Programs- OR - one session of all Gateway 2 level classes at SAL (including G2 WC) for transfer to Graduate Programs.

Step 2:

Follow the admission procedures for applying to the program of your choice. Be sure to submit the application form, transcripts, financial support letter, and any other required documents to the university plus the application fee. **Complete a transfer form** and submit it to the SAL office.

Step 3:

Receive "B" or higher grades in ALL of your SAL classes. Have 90% overall attendance in your classes -- and complete ALL of your assignments. Be sure to talk with your teachers to find out how you are doing in your classes.

Step 4:

Complete a TOEFL Waiver Request Form at the SAL office. At the end of your studies, a Letter of Recommendation will be sent directly to the university. It will include your most recent SAL grades, your instructors' comments, your TOEFL score, and a recommendation for a TOEFL Waiver.

Step 5:

Take the English Placement Test at NDNU for Undergraduate Admission -OR - GMAT at ETS for Graduate Admission and attend all required "new student" functions at NDNU.
