## Just follow these 5 easy steps:

### Step 1:

Complete a minimum of one session of -- Expansion 2 Level classes at SAL (including E2 Level WC) for transfer to **De Anza, Foothill, West Valley or San Jose City College,**

### Step 2:

Follow the admission procedures for applying to the community college of your choice. Be sure to submit the application form, transcripts, financial support letter, and any other necessary documents to the college plus the application fee. **Complete a transfer form** and submit it to the SAL office.

### Step 3:

Receive "B" or higher grades in **ALL** of your SAL classes. Have **90% overall attendance** in your classes -- and complete **ALL** of your assignments. Be sure to talk with your teachers to find out how you are doing in your classes.

### Step 4:

Complete a **TOEFL Waiver Request form** at the SAL office. At the end of your studies, a **Letter of Recommendation** will be sent directly to the college of your choice. The letter will include your most recent SAL grades, your instructors' comments, your TOEFL score, and a recommendation for a **TOEFL Waiver**.

### Step 5:

Take the **Math and ESL Placement Tests** at the community college of your choice -- De Anza, Foothill, West Valley, or San Jose City, and **attend their mandatory new student "Orientation" program.**
